Dr. Chitra Sinha has been in academia for over three decades in India, USA, Sweden, South Africa and Bahrain. She is presently associated with the Centre for Gender Research (Genus vetenskap), Uppsala University, Sweden and the University of Free State, Bloemfontein, South Africa. She has a Ph.D. from the University of Mumbai, India and has taught at the University of Mumbai; SNDT Women's University, India; Visva Bharati University, India; and Royal University for Women, Bahrain; covering subjects ranging from research methodology, gender studies, human rights, history, political science, sociology, culture studies to journalism and media studies. She has designed and conducted training programs for college and university faculty, University Teachers' Orientation Programmes and special training sessions for corporate executives. Dr. Sinha has extensive experience in Curriculum Development and Quality Assurance at University level.
